Hon. James Anderson is a Circuit Judge with the 15th Judicial Circuit in Montgomery, Alabama. Judge Anderson received his undergraduate degree from Huntingdon College. In 1979, he earned his Juris Doctor at the Cumberland School of Law of Samford University and was admitted to practice law in Alabama the same year. Judge Anderson joined the Montgomery-based law firm of Hill, Hill, Carter, Franco, Cole, & Black. He became a partner at the firm in 1983 and continued to practice there until 1988, when he co-founded the private practice firm of Beers, Anderson, Jackson, Patty, & Fawal, P.C. He was elected to the Bench in 2016.

Jana Russell Garner, JRG Law Offices, Selma, Alabama. Jana’s practice focusses on plaintiff and defense civil litigation representing individuals, families, businesses, insurance companies and financial institutions, and other business entities in jury and non-jury matters. Jana is a registered Mediator with the Alabama Center for Dispute Resolution. She mediates civil, domestic, foreclosure and appellate cases. She was recognized as the Alabama Pro Bono Mediator in 2015. Jana earned her Juris Doctorate in 1997 from Cumberland School of Law and was admitted to the Alabama State Bar the same year.
