ORDER OF REFERRAL TO MEDIATION IN THE PARENTS ARE FOREVER FAMILY MEDIATION PROGRAM

This matter comes before the court for appointment of a mediator to be utilized in this matter in conjunction with the Parents are Forever Family Mediation Program ongoing through the Alabama Center for Dispute Resolution, Inc. (Center) It is hereby **Ordered**, **Adjudged** and **Decreed** as follows:

- 1. That parties are ordered to participate in family mediation pursuant to §6-6-20 and §6-6-25 Code of Alabama (1975) and the Alabama Civil Court Mediation Rules for the purpose of creating a parenting plan (covering parenting time, responsibilities, support of the children) and a financial plan specifically suited to their needs and the needs of their children. This plan will be submitted to the judge. Family income must be under \$60,000. There must be minor children.
- 2. Parties have selected ______as mediator. Mediator has the required 40 hours of divorce and family mediation training and is listed on the *Alabama State Court Mediator Roster as a domestic relations mediator*.

Or

Parties have 10 days to select a mediator with above qualifications and notify the court.

- 3. In mediation, attorneys and parents will work cooperatively and jointly with each other and the mediator toward the goals of a parenting plan and a financial plan. All financial and other materials requested by the mediator will be provided to the mediator prior to mediation.
- 4. Mediator is required to notify the Center to obtain a case ID number and copies of the forms that must be submitted for payment.
- 5. Upon completion of mediation, mediator shall submit confidential case summary and invoice to Center for payment.
